About Digital Fuse

Digital Fuse is registered in England. By visiting and submitting information via our site, you are accepting and consenting to the practices described in this statement.

Privacy Policy

This privacy policy sets out the basis on which any personal data we hold is stored and used.

The extent of your personal data we hold usually includes the following:

- Your name (so we know what to call you)
- Your email address (so that we can send you information and updates)
- Your phone number (if you have supplied it to us and asked us to contact you by telephone)
- Your address (if you have supplied it to us and asked us to contact you in writing)

Google Analytics

We may collect the following information via Google Analytics when you use the site:

- Details of how you used our service, such as your search queries
- Internet protocol address
- Device event information such as crashes, system activity, hardware settings, browser type, browser language, the date and time of your request and referral URL
- Cookies that may uniquely identify your browser or your Google account

Cookies

Like nearly all websites, ours uses cookies. These are text files that sit on your computer and store your browsing history, which can make using our website a better experience. Cookies also collect standard information about visitor behaviour, which are used to improve visitor experience and compile statistical reports on website activity.

Cookies cannot provide access to personal computers or personal information. However you can remove cookies from your browser and set your preferences so that it doesn't accept cookies.
